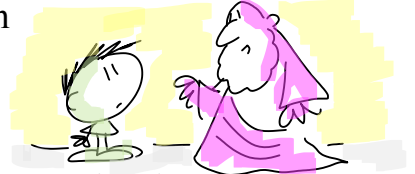


## John 16: 1-4

Topic: a) What lies ahead?

a) There was a boy who had to go on a journey. The boy stood at the beginning of the road, looked ahead and wondered what it was like down the road and what his journey would be like. Just then he saw an old man walking towards him. The boy stopped him and asked him what the road was like up ahead. The old man told the boy that there were beautiful hills along the road. They were sunny and green with beautiful flowers growing on them. You could climb to the top and see forever! The old man said that there were also deep valleys along the road. These valleys were dark and cold and could be very scary.



- Your life is like that road. You will have beautiful hills (good times) ahead and deep dark valleys ahead too (sad times).

Topic: b) How will we ever get through?

b) Psalm 23: 1 The LORD is my shepherd; I shall not want. 2 He makes me to lie down in green pastures; He leads me beside the still waters. 3 He restores my soul; He leads me in the paths of righteousness For His name's sake. 4 Yea, though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil; For You are with me; Your rod and Your staff, they comfort me. 5 You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies; You anoint my head with oil; My cup runs over. 6 Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me All the days of my life; And I will dwell in the house of the LORD Forever.

b) There was a boy who had to go on a dangerous journey. His friend who was much older, wiser and stronger than the boy said he would go with him. The boy was still nervous about the journey. He said to his friend, "But what if I get lost?" His friend answered, "You won't...I know the way." "What if I get scared?" "I will protect you." "What if I fall into a hole?" "I will rescue you." "What if I get weak?" "I will carry you." The boy started off on his journey hand in hand with his friend. He knew that his protector would be with him.



- Jesus said, "I will never leave you." You are never alone. He is the way. He is watching over you. He knows what will happen. He is in control of everything. He will rescue you. He will carry you. He will never leave you your whole life.

## John 16: 5-15

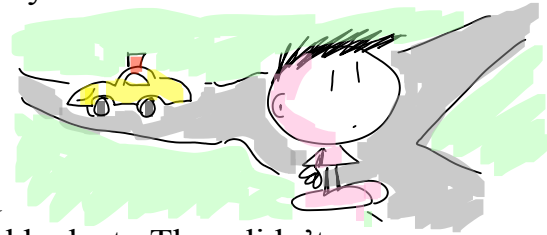
Topic: a) Who is the Holy Spirit?

a) God the Father is God. Jesus, the Son of God is God. The Holy Spirit is God.

- These three are all the same person.
- There is only one God.

Topic: b) The Holy Spirit convicts.

b) Freddy was allowed to go to his friend's house on the condition that he come straight home at five o'clock. Five o'clock came and Freddy started for home. He was walking down the road towards home when he saw another road he had never been down before. He turned off the road he was supposed to be on and started down this new road. Suddenly the "kid safety patrol" came by. They told Freddy that he was going down the wrong road and if he kept going it was going to get dark and he would be lost. They didn't make Freddy turn back to the right road. They just told him what would be best. Now it's up to Freddy to decide what he is going to do.



• When we start to get away from God and do things that will hurt us (sin), the Holy Spirit lets us know. Then we have to choose what we will do.

Topic: c) The Holy Spirit shows us what is needed.

c) Brenda is going to Hawaii to visit her grandmother. Brenda got a suitcase and packed everything she would need for the trip. She called her grandmother to let her know she was coming. She got a ride to the airport. Once there she went to get on the plane but the person in charge of boarding told her that she needed something that she didn't have. What is it?



• Nobody can get to heaven on their own. The Holy Spirit tells us what we need to get to heaven.

- Who do we need?

Topic: d) The Holy Spirit guides us into all truth.

d) Elza has to go from here to there. She has a map. The problem is as soon as she started on her journey from here, she lost her map. She asked some people for directions. One of the them was mean and gave Elza the wrong directions on purpose and she got really lost. Another person she asked didn't know how to get to

there. He was no help at all. Another person she asked said he thought he knew the way but it turns out he really didn't and Elza got even more lost. Finally she called the man who made the map. He told her exactly how to get from here to there. She followed his instructions and was there in no time.



- What did the man who made the map do for her? (Told her the truth)
- There are a millions and millions of thoughts and ideas in the world. The Holy Spirit tells us what is true and what isn't.

Topic: e) The Holy Spirit glorifies Jesus.

e) Sam is really hungry. Sam's friend says that he knows a place that makes the best hot dogs in the whole world. Sam's friend takes him to this little restaurant. There is a cook behind the counter. He makes two hot dogs for the boys. Sam eats his and says, "Wow that really is the best hot dog in the whole world!"



- Who should get the credit for the best hot dog in the world? (The cook)
- What did Sam's friend do? (Brought him there)
- The Holy Spirit brings people to Jesus so they can get saved.

## John 16: 16-22

Topic: a) With Jesus...there is always joy in the end.

a) There was a mouse playing in the sunshine. It was bright and warm and he was having a great time. Suddenly it began to get dark. The sun went down and night began. The mouse was very sad because the sun had gone away. It got darker and darker. Finally the mouse fell asleep, sad because of the darkness. When he woke up he couldn't believe what he saw. The sun was back! It was bright and warm and the mouse ran outside to play all day.



- Sadness is like darkness. There are times when we are sad.
- When Jesus comes back the day will begin and never end.

## John 16: 23-24

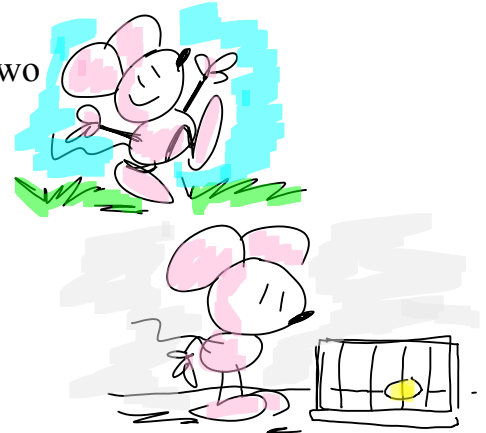
Topic: a) What kind of things bring joy?

a) You are hungry. There are two places selling food. One sells cheeseburgers.... delicious big burgers with cheese, tomatoes, lettuce and a special sauce that tastes really good. The other place sells water burgers which consist of two pieces of wet bread. Which would bring you greater joy?



a) There is a mouse. The mouse has to choose between two things. There is a big open field where he can play and run free. Up by the house is a cage trap with a piece of cheese in it.

- Which would bring greater joy?
- Sin is like that trap.
- God wants you to be free from sin that would hurt you.



a) Would you rather have a wide screen TV or mom and dad's love? (Can you see their love?) ...A video game or friendship from someone you like? (Can you see friendship?) ...A new bike or to know that you're safe? (Can you see safe?) ...An ice cream cone or not to be afraid? (Can you see peace?)

- The things we can't see are better.
- God gives us both but the things that give us real joy are the things we can't see. These things last forever.

a) Billy went to the park. He wanted to go on a river run. This is where you get into rubber boats and paddle down the river. There were two places in the park where you could ride down the river. One was run by a man named Zig. Zig gets everyone in a boat, tells them what to do and they go down the river heading towards a huge water fall. By the time they get there it's too late. They all go over the falls. The other one is a park ranger who gets everyone in the boat, tells them what to do and they ride down the river safely. They go through fast rapids, laugh and see all sorts of wildlife. They have a good trip and get home safely. Which one of these two would you choose to be with and obey?

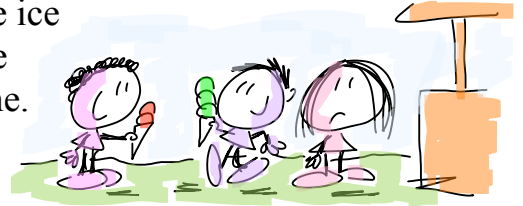


- There is no better life than being with God and obeying Him.

### **John 16: 25-28**

Topic: a) Why does God love you?

- Why? (Because of what he did)

- Why? (Because of what they did)

a) When God's people left Egypt, the Egyptians chased them to the Red Sea. The people were scared. God parted the water so the people could cross on dry ground and be safe. He saved them that day. When the people got to the other side they worshiped God and loved him.

- Why? (Because of what He did)

a) Why does God love us?

- What have we done that would make God love us? (Nothing...we have sinned)
- Then why does He love us? (Because He is love. We have believed in His Son. We have taken the gift of life in Jesus)

## John 16: 29-32

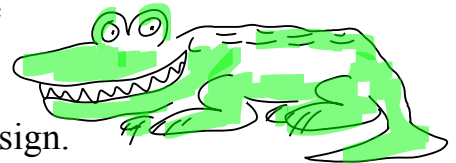
Topic: a) What are consequences?

a) Consequences are what happen whenever we do something.

a) There is a sign at the zoo..."Do not put your hand in the lions mouth." A boy comes to the zoo. He sees the sign. Then he reaches over the bars of the cage and puts his hand in the lion's mouth. "Lefty" as he is called now was sad that he didn't obey the sign.

a) There is still another sign at the zoo..."Do not stick your head in the bear cage." Lefty Limpy sees the sign. Then he walked over and stuck his head in the bear cage. "Lefty Limpy Baldy" as he is now called was sad that he didn't obey the sign.



- Everything we do has a consequence.

a) Billy and Fred want to spend the night over at their friend Pete's house. Billy's mother told him that if he didn't clean his room he wasn't going anywhere. Fred's mother told him the same thing. Fred spent the afternoon cleaning his room. When he was done it looked perfect. Billy spent the afternoon watching television. Later on Billy told his mom that he was going over to Pete's house. His mom looked at his room. "Oh no you're not!!" she said. Fred told his mom that he was going over to Pete's house. His mom looked at his room. "Have a good time!" she said.

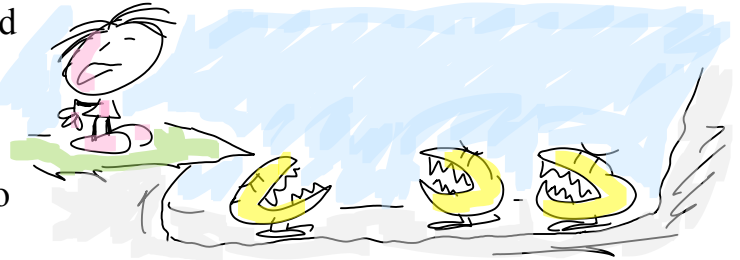


- Did Billy's and Fred's choices have consequences?

Topic: b) How do we avoid bad consequences?

c) Luke 15: 11-24....The prodigal son

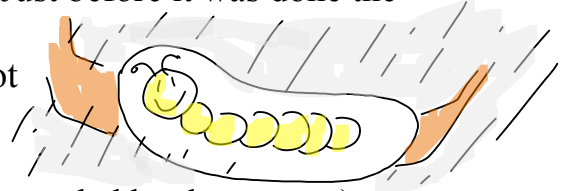
- Did the boy have bad consequences?
