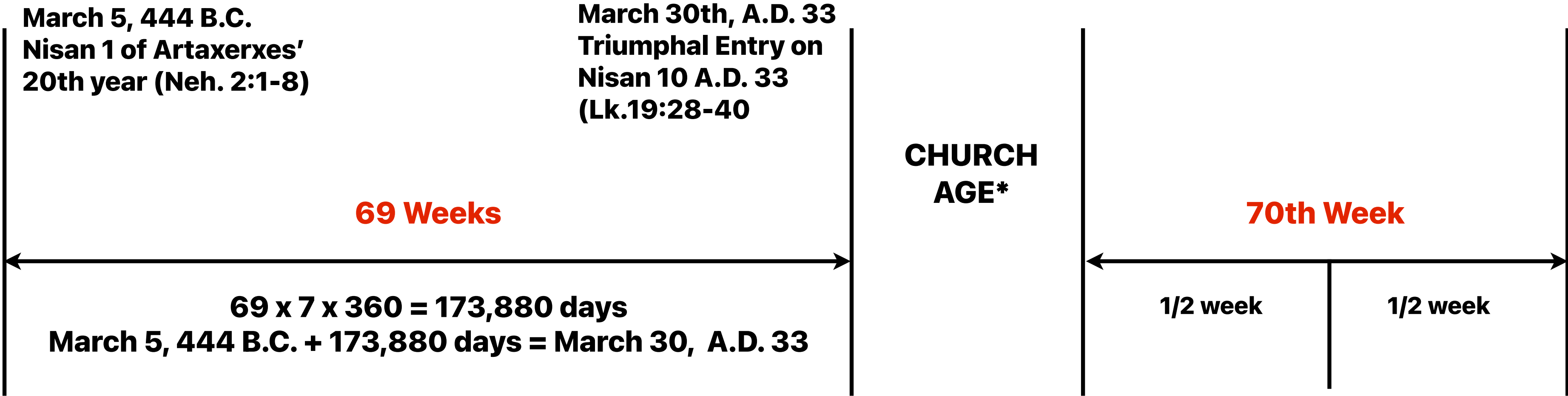
24 “Seventy weeks are determined For your people and for your holy city, To finish the transgression, To make an end of sins,

Verification

444 B.C. to A.D. 33 = 476 yrs.

476 years x 365.24219879 = 173,885

+ days between March 5 and March 30 = 25 days

$\frac{\text{-----}}{\text{173,880}}$

* Messiah "cut off" after 69 weeks - April 3, A.D. 33

Rationale for 360-day Years

1/2 week - Daniel 9:27

Time, times, 1/2 time - Dan.7:25, 12:7; Rev. 12:14

1,260 days - Rev. 12:6; 11:3

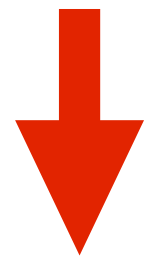
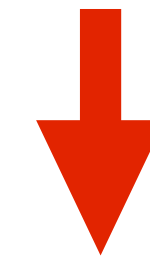
42 months - Rev. 11:2; 13:5

Thus: 42 months = 1,260 days = time, times, half a time - 1/2 week

Therefore: month = 30 days; year = 360 days

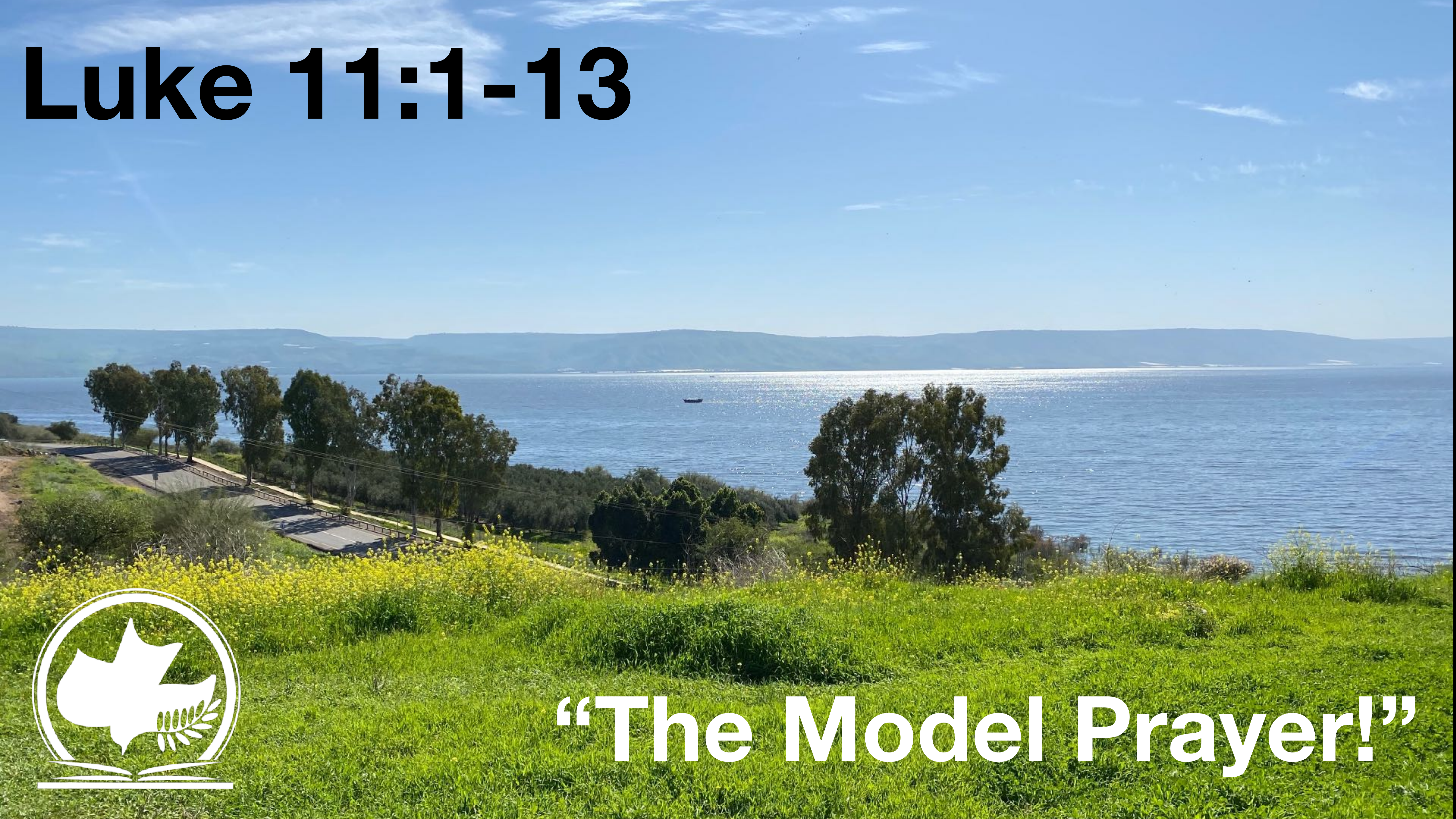
