<p><b>Luke 6:20 "Blessed are you poor, For yours is the kingdom of God."</b></p>	<p><b>Luke 6:24 "But woe to you who are rich, For you have received your consolation."</b></p>
<p><b>Luke 6:21a "Blessed are you who hunger now, For you shall be filled."</b></p>	<p><b>Luke 6:25a "Woe to you who are full, For you shall hunger."</b></p>
<p><b>Luke 6:21b "Blessed are you who weep now, For you shall laugh."</b></p>	<p><b>Luke 6:25b "Woe to you who laugh now, For you shall mourn and weep."</b></p>
<p><b>Luke 6:22-23 "Blessed are you when men hate you, And when they exclude you, And revile you, and cast out your name as evil, For the Son of Man's sake. 23 Rejoice in that day and leap for joy! For indeed your reward is great in heaven, For in like manner their fathers did to the prophets."</b></p>	<p><b>Luke 6:26 "Woe to you when all men speak well of you, For so did their fathers to the false prophets."</b></p>

## **Mark 12:29-31 (NKJV)**

**29 Jesus answered him, “The first of all the commandments is: Hear, O Israel, the LORD our God, the LORD is one. 30 And you shall love the LORD your God with all your heart, with all your soul, with all your mind, and with all your strength.’ This is the first commandment. 31 And the second, like it, is this: You shall love your neighbor as yourself.’ There is no other commandment greater than these.”**

### **Commandment #1**

### **Commandment #2**

### **Commandment #4**

**Remember the Sabbath day, to keep it holy.**

### **Commandment #5**

**Honor your father and your mother...**

### **Commandment #6**

**You shall not murder**

### **Commandment #7**

**You shall not commit adultery**

### **Commandment #8**

**You shall not steal**

**You shall not bear false witness against your neighbor**

### **Commandment #10**

**You shall not covet...**
