Feeding 5,000 Primarily Jews Galilee, near Bethsaida 5 loaves, 2 fish 12 baskets over Crowd with Him 1 day Spring of year (green grass) Tried to make Him King

Feeding 4,000 Primarily Gentiles The Decapolis 7 loaves, "a few fish" 7 baskets over Crowd with Him 3 days Summer season No popular response
